

Progress on the Projects (in May 2020)

- **57 ISPs** have participated in the projects.
- A survey on about **110 million IP addresses** of the ISPs was conducted.
- **NOTICE: 287** devices were **detected** and ISPs have been notified.
- **NICTER: 154**(daily avg.) devices were **detected** and ISPs have been notified.

Results of the "NOTICE" Project

Number of IP addresses which were successfully logged-in to with weak password settings and were subject to user alert

287

Ref) Total number in FY2019: 2,249

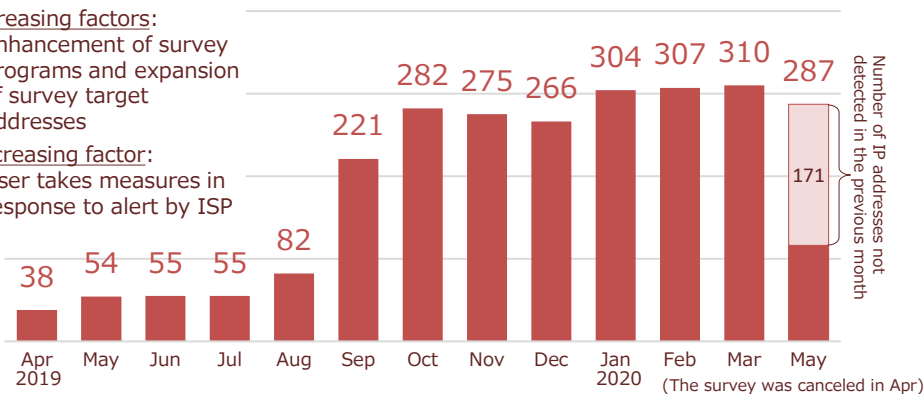
Devices in which password could be entered: 106 thousand

Increasing factors:

Enhancement of survey programs and expansion of survey target addresses

Decreasing factor:

User takes measures in response to alert by ISP



Results of the NICTER-Alert Project*

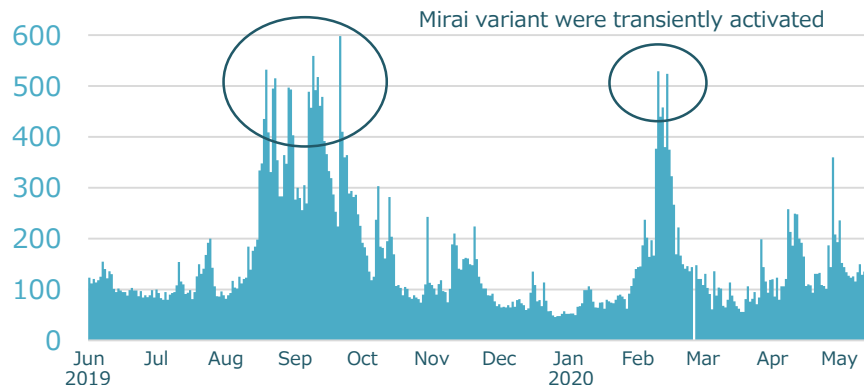
* Project to alert users of IoT devices infected with malware
